This semester, the above-named, carbon-based organism has successfully sustained existence as a cohesive collection of around  $7 \times 10^{27}$  atoms. Correctly functioning appetitive and consuming behaviors, triggered by interplay between the digestive tract, adipose tissue, and the brain, have supported adequate energy intake to sustain normal activity levels. The organism's skeletal system has functioned well together with skeletal muscles to enable movement by applying force to levers. Reception of light, focused by a lens, and conversion of the resulting images into electrical impulses sent to the brain has provided an adequate level of visual perception, accompanied by processing of sound waves in the inner ear to provide auditory access to the environment.
